Q: What is Eco Commerce Workforce Training Program?

A: It is a corporate community partnership program that works with companies to facilitate and enable the awareness, development and implementation of Eco Commerce workforce training programs.

Q: Who can join Eco Commerce Workforce Training Programs?

A: Private and Public Companies, Non-Profits, Government Agencies, NGOs, and Individuals can join.

Q: What happens when a company joins?

A: Our program coordinator meets with your company representative and conducts a survey on your current workforce training program. After the survey results have been tallied, the program coordinator develops a brief program report, including a list of key contacts.

Q: What is considered to be corporate community involvement?

A: Community involvement include Corporate Giving, Corporate Programs, Community Education, Employee Volunteerism, and Employee Giving.

Q: Why join Eco Commerce Workforce Training Program?

A: This partnership program gives companies a chance to promote their offerings or give back to the communities, while also enhancing the company's recruiting, team building, retention, morale and employee satisfaction through education involvement programs. In fact, our recent survey of a sample of companies, 98% of the employees surveyed said they were proud of their company's efforts in workforce training.
